MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT, BRUCE RIESER

This will be a watershed mid-term election nationally and even more so for Montgomery county. It marks both a changing of the guard at the statewide level and a chance for voters to choose new leaders for our federal and county government.

Montgomery County is at a crossroads. Our rapid development, especially since the opening TX-99, requires creative and determined leadership that puts the needs of our residents at the forefront.

The retirements of conservative stalwarts Brandon Creighton and Steve Toth will leave a serious vacuum in local state leadership. Senator Creighton is now the Chancellor of Texas Tech University and Representative Toth has chosen to run for Congress in CD2. We thank them for their service and wish them continued success in their endeavors.

In our view, the quality of life in Montgomery County has seriously deteriorated in the prior eight years. Mobility, Water, county infrastructure and soaring property taxes are creating serious issues for our residents. We need new leadership to reverse these trends and to begin effective planning to anticipate future growth.

In this election we are recommending voters finish the work they started in the last two cycles with the election of Commissioners Gray and Wheeler and replace incumbents Charlie Riley (12 years) as Commissioner in Precinct 2 and Mark Keough (8 years) as County Judge. Both these men have had ample time to address these issues and have failed to do so; it is time for a change.

Concurrently, we are also advocating for new leadership in CD2, HD3 and HD16. Steve Toth has done an outstanding job in HD15 over his 5 terms in office. We are endorsing Steve in his race to replace Dan Crenshaw (6 years) in Tx CD2. Twelve-year incumbent Tx House Reps Cecil Bell (HD3) and Will Metcalf (HD16), broke ranks with the Republican Caucus to join Democrats in electing Dustin Burrows as House Speaker in the last session. We are endorsing conservative candidates Kristin Plaisance (HD3) and Jon Bouche (HD16) to replace them.
